### IDENTIFICATION OF SLOW AND ADVANCED LEARNERS

### Identification Methods of slow learners and advanced learners:


Identification Methods of slow learners and advanced learners process the following input is needed

- 2. Class test result.
- 3. Class observation by the subject teacher.

### Assessment of the learning levels the students:

- Slow learners and advanced learners would be identified for each subject separately by respective subject teacher.
- The student securing marks below 50% would be identified as slow learners and the student securing marks above 70% would be identified as advanced learners.
- After that separate list are prepared for both type of learners for further monitoring and conduction of problem solving sessions/revision sessions for them.
- Process to identify of slow learners and advanced learners would be conducted immediately after declaration of preceding the university exam result or after one month of teaching in case of first year.
