
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Report on soft skill development in Team work

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
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Report on Employability Skill Development, specifically focusing on Technical Skills




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Report on Employability Skill Development: Leadership and Management Skills


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Report on soft skill development in Learning emotional intelligence


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Report Personality and Professional Development in Empathy

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

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
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Report on Soft skill development in Critical Thinking

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

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
